



A one mile walk around the town from Croft Road to lovely Chapel Green and The Broadway. Passing shops and entirely on pavements alongside roads you'll not be too far from other people.

Getting here:

Plenty of parking options in Crowborough, Croft Road Car Park is the nearest. TN6 1DR.

Buses 29, 224, 225, 226 and 228 stop on High Street 200m from the start or 50m from the nearest point of the walk. Crowborough railway station is over a mile away from the nearest point.

Entirely on pavements with no steps, stiles or gates. Dropped kerbs at all road crossings. Long ramp from Montargis Terrace to Croft Road which exceeds 15%. No slopes over 10% on the rest of the walk. Suitable for some wheelchairs and standard pushchairs. Seats available but many require crossing the road. Some shelter available. Toilets in the supermarket near the start. Many shops and places to eat and drink. Not waymarked, follow road names. Take care crossing side roads and look out for concealed driveways and vehicles crossing the pavement.

- 1 Begin on Montargis Terrace beside Waitrose and Croft Road Car Park. Head down the ramp (gradient of 15%) and carefully cross the road.
- 2 Turn right and follow alongside Croft Road away from the town.
- 3 Turn left onto Church Road and pass Chapel Green.

- 4 Turn left onto Crowborough Hill and head towards the town.
- 5 Turn left onto Croft Road.
- 6 Cross Croft Road at the zebra crossing and head back to the ramp just after Waitrose.



Distance: 1 mile (1.6 km)

Ascent: 36 metres (118 feet)
