

Crowborough Common

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A pleasant walk on quiet lanes and through woods to the golf course on Crowborough Common.

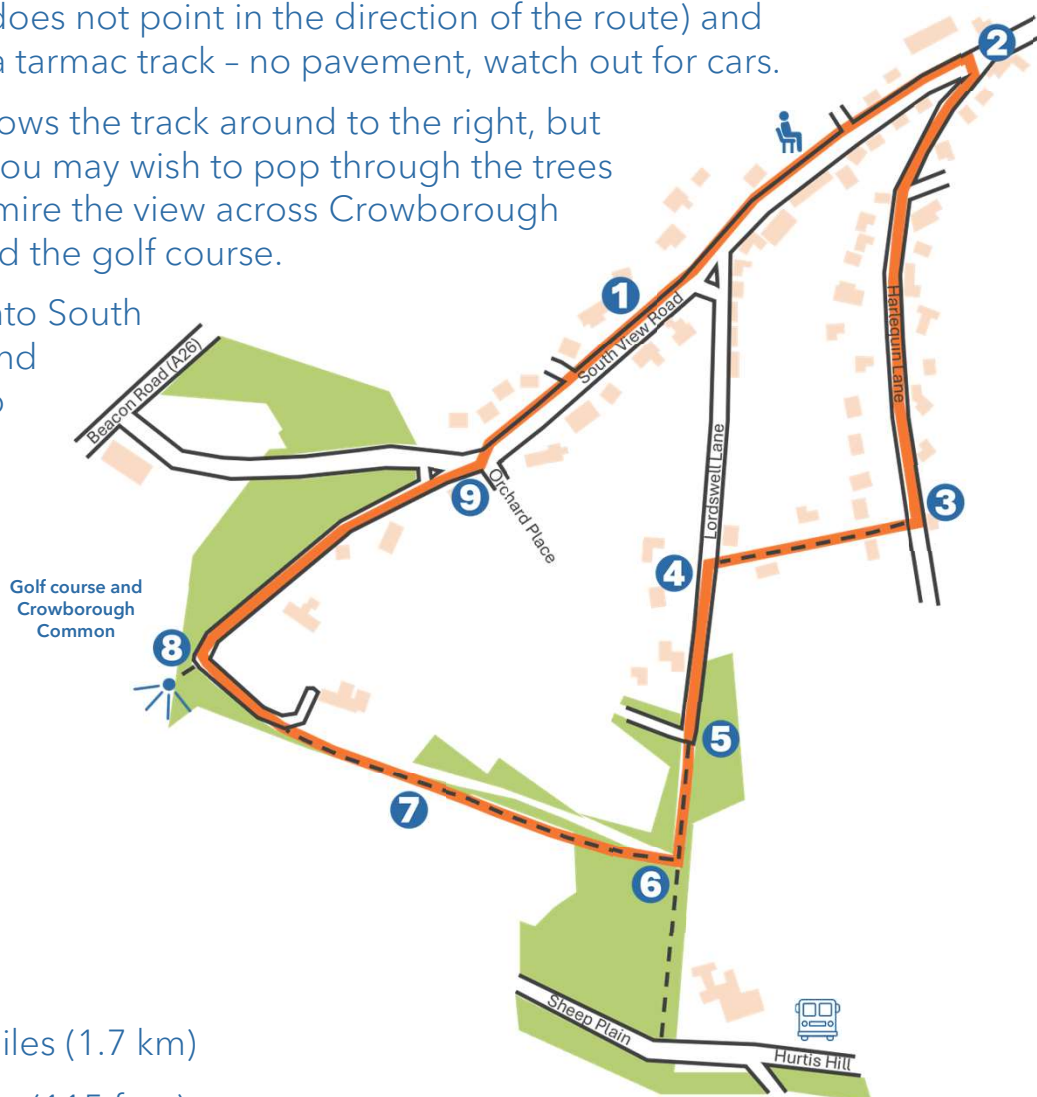
Getting here:

Park along South View Road between Orchard Place and Harlequin Lane (observe parking restrictions). TN6 1HW.

Bus 29 stops at Windlesham Manor on Hurtis Hill 240m away from the walk. From the bus stop head onto Sheep Plain. Take care - no pavement and a blind bend. Turn right to pass by a metal gate onto a mud track to join the walk.

Mixed walking surface with pavements, paved roads, grass and mud paths. Uneven in the woods with exposed tree roots and puddles after rain. No steps, stiles or gates. No slopes over 10%. Not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs. One seat on South View Road, none elsewhere. No shelter, toilets or refreshments. Not waymarked, follows obvious paths. Some footpaths are signposted. Harlequin Lane and Lordswell Lane are quiet residential roads with no pavement, keep to one side and watch out for cars.

- 1 Begin on South View Road and head away from Beacon Road.
- 2 Turn right onto Harlequin Lane.
- 3 After a house called 'Pippins' turn right onto a footpath between two hedges. This path may be narrowed by overgrowth.
- 4 Turn left onto Lordswell Lane.
- 5 As the lane bends to the right pass the metal gate to take the track ahead.
- 6 At the fingerpost turn right onto a muddy and uneven path and cross a small bridge. Emerge onto the golf course and keep right by the bushes - watch out for golf balls.
- 7 Take the small mud path which heads behind the large tree, pass a footpath sign (which does not point in the direction of the route) and continue to a tarmac track - no pavement, watch out for cars.
- 8 The walk follows the track around to the right, but before that you may wish to pop through the trees ahead to admire the view across Crowborough Common and the golf course.
- 9 Turn right onto South View Road and head back to where you began.



Distance: 1.05 miles (1.7 km)

Ascent: 35 metres (115 feet)
