

Jeffery's Wood

Just under one mile through Jubilee Meadow, into Jeffery's Wood to the Ghyll and back via Green Lane. You'll need a steady foot through the woods, which are rich with wildlife, beautiful wildflowers and a pretty stream.

Getting here:

Small car park on Green Lane, downhill from Vachery Street (Palesgate Lane). TN6 2XB.

Buses 29, 29B and 228 stop on Eridge Road 250m from the start. Crowborough railway station is about a mile away from the nearest point of the walk.

Mixed walking surface with paved paths, grass and mud paths which may have puddles after rain. Uneven paths in the woods with rocks and exposed tree roots. A few short uneven and steep slopes. A long, slippery slope uphill, which exceeds 15%, after the bridge. No stiles or gates. Not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs. Seats only near the start and one other bench in the meadow. No shelter. No toilets. Refreshments available from a shop on Green Lane. Not waymarked, follow well walked paths.

- 1 From the car park pass through the gap next to the gate, follow the path into the meadow and head towards the play park.
- 2 Bear left before the play park and follow the trodden path through the grass along the meadow.
- 3 Head to the far-right corner of the meadow and pass through a gap in the hedge. The path in the woods is muddy, may be wet and has exposed tree routes and rocks.
- 4 After a while the path meets the ghyll, continue on the path alongside the ghyll.
- 5 When the path splits take the lower path to continue alongside the ghyll.
- 6 Cross the wooden bridge, turn right and head uphill. The path here is uneven and steep (+15%) with a slippery brick surface.
- 7 At the end of the path pass through the posts (width restriction of 50cm). Turn right and follow the pavement alongside the road back to the car park. Take care as Green Lane can be busy.



Distance: 0.95 mile (1.6 km)

Ascent: 23 metres (75 feet)
