



**Just over a mile through lush woodland, into the Ashdown Forest and back along roads. This walk is reasonably flat underfoot, other paths not on the route but shown on the map are considerably more uneven.**

**Getting here:**

Paid for parking at St Johns Car Park on St John's Road, TN6 1SA.

Buses 29, 226 and 228 stop at Crowborough Cross 0.8 miles (1.3km) from the start of the walk. Crowborough railway station is about 2.5 miles away.

Includes a flat compacted mud track, pavements and paved roads. May be uneven and muddy in places. No steps, stiles or gates. The steepest part of the walk is on Old Lane where the slope exceeds 10%. Suitable for some off-road wheelchairs and pushchairs. Dropped kerbs at all road crossings. No pavement on Glenmore Road. The pavement on Old Road is bumpy, may be slippery and is narrowed to less than one metre in places by overgrowth. No seats, shelter, toilets or refreshments. Not waymarked, follow obvious paths and roads.

- 1 From St Johns Car Park head to the road and turn left.
- 2 Take either of the paths immediately on the left to follow a good wide track alongside the wire fence.
- 3 Continue ahead to pass between the wooden posts and follow a compacted mud track.
- 4 Cross the wooden bridge onto the road. Take care, no pavements.
- 5 Turn left onto Old Lane (with pavements).
- 6 At the top of the Hill cross to the pavement on the opposite side of the road.
- 7 Turn left onto St John's Road and back to the car park.



**Distance:** 1.1 miles (1.77km)

**Ascent:** 37 metres (121 feet)
