

# Walshes Park

**Just over a mile through this stunning park with wetlands, historic sites, meadows, tree avenues, far reaching views and sculptures. With good paths and lovely scenery this space is an absolute gem!**

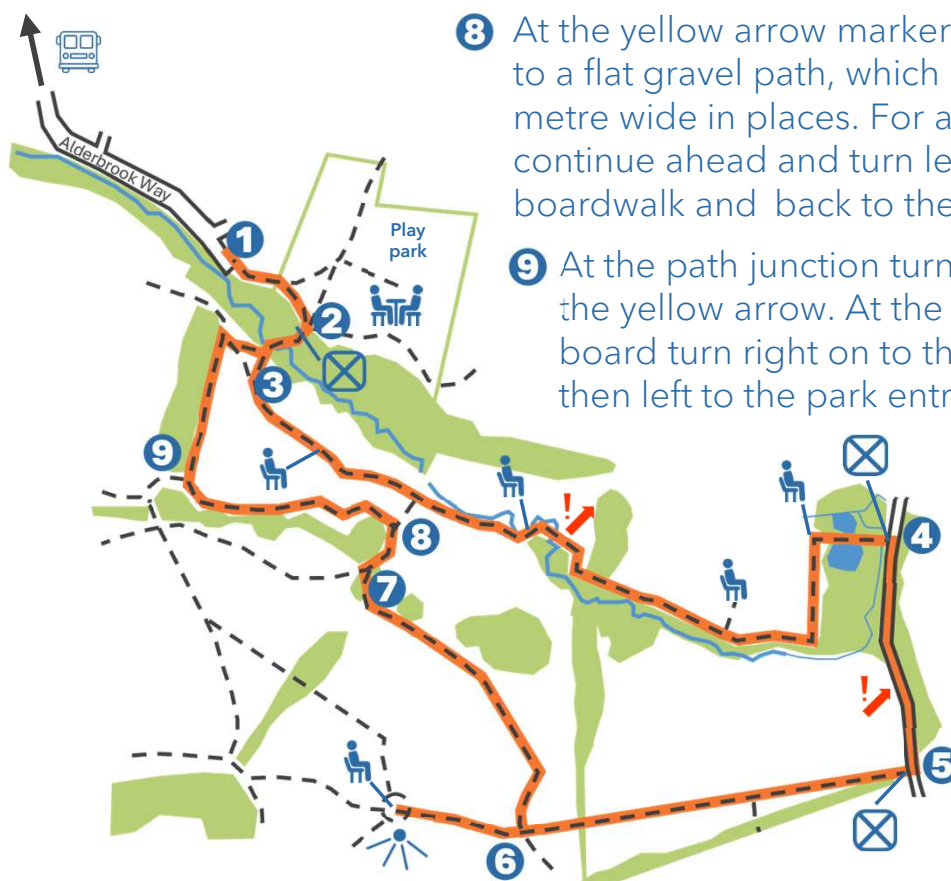
## **Getting here:**

Small amount of on road parking along Alderbrook Way and two accessible spaces. TN6 3EF

Bus 226 stops on Alderbrook Close at the top of Alderbrook Way 200m from the start of the walk. Crowborough railway station is over a mile away from the start.

The walking surface is flat including wooden boardwalks and paved or gravel paths. No steps, or stiles. There are three kissing gates which are one metre wide. Short incline on the boardwalk section which is 13%, the steepest slope on the rest of the walk is 13% uphill. Suitable for some standard wheelchairs and pushchairs but it may be a little bumpy in places. Seats mostly on the boardwalk section. No shelter, toilets or refreshments. Follow boardwalk and obvious paths, way markers towards the end.

- 1 Begin at the far end of Alderbrook Way and follow the path.
- 2 Bear right, pass through a large metal kissing gate (+1m gap) into Walshes Park and follow the boardwalk.
- 3 Bear left at the junction and follow the boardwalk, steepest incline is 13%.
- 4 Pass through a large metal kissing gate, turn right and head uphill, 13%.
- 5 Turn right to pass through another metal kissing gate, head along the tree lined avenue then pass through a hedge.
- 6 At the gravel path crossroads continue ahead to the sculpture in the circle for a great view and seats. Turn around, return to the crossroads and take the path downhill on the left. Pass a marker post with a yellow arrow.
- 7 Pass through a gap in the hedge and immediately turn right, following the yellow arrow. After a few metres follow the path ahead between trees, also shown by a yellow arrow.



- 8 At the yellow arrow marker post turn left on to a flat gravel path, which is less than one metre wide in places. For a wider path continue ahead and turn left on to the boardwalk and back to the park entrance.
- 9 At the path junction turn right to follow the yellow arrow. At the information board turn right on to the boardwalk and then left to the park entrance.

**Distance:** 1.05 miles (1.7 km)

**Ascent:** 26 metres (85 feet)
